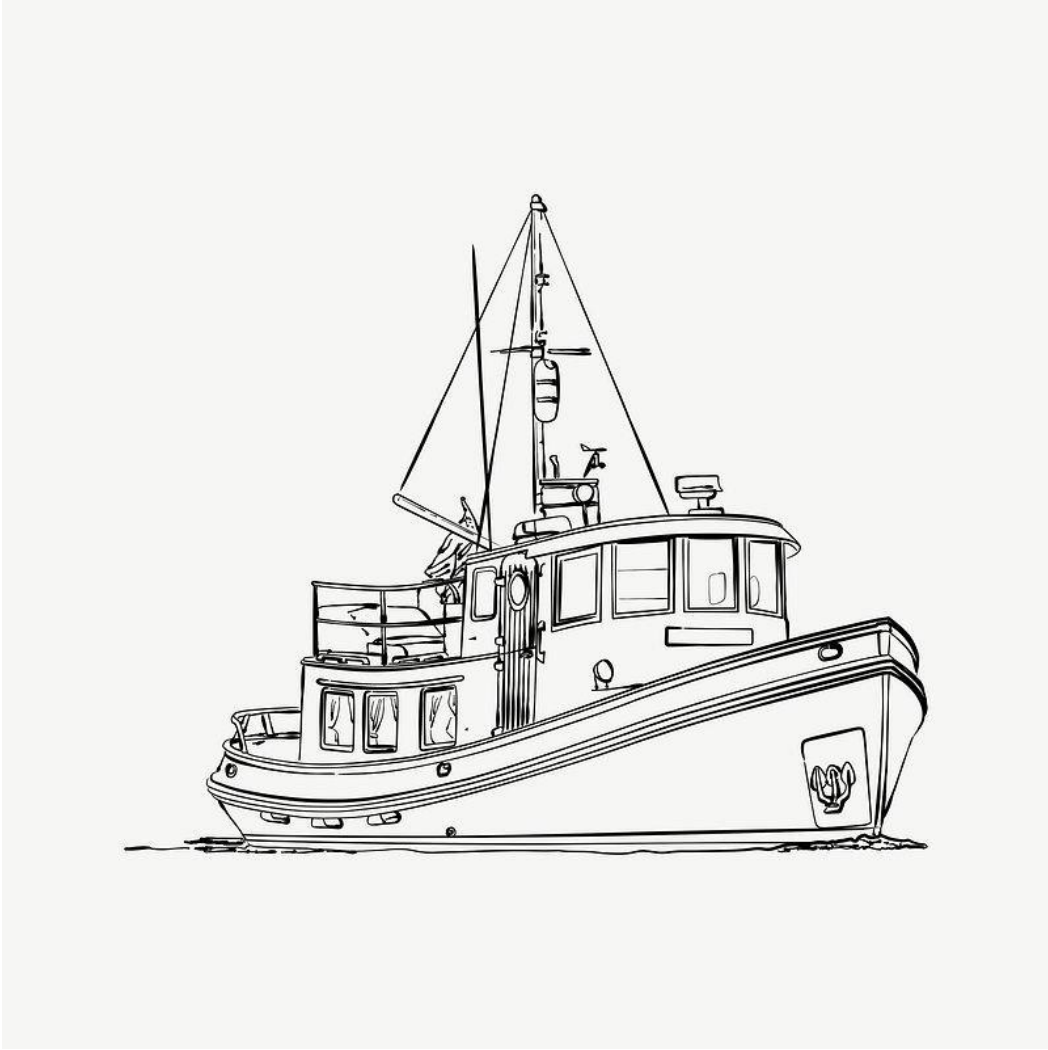




Stories of the Kingdom

Kingdom of God.”

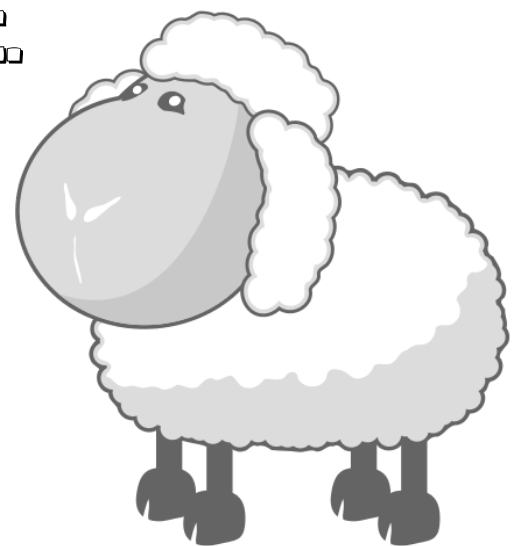
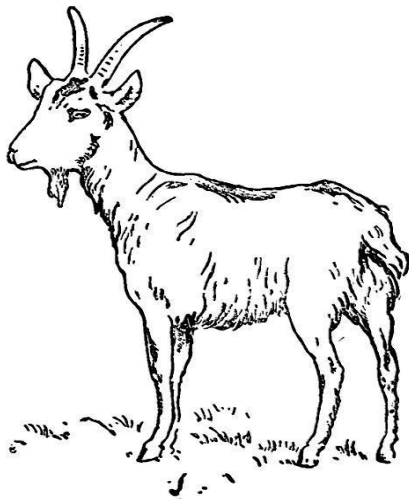
Jesus Himself was a
